A 450-ton meteor crashed in Chicora, PA. north of Pittsburgh. The only casualty was one cow.... RIP. (1938)

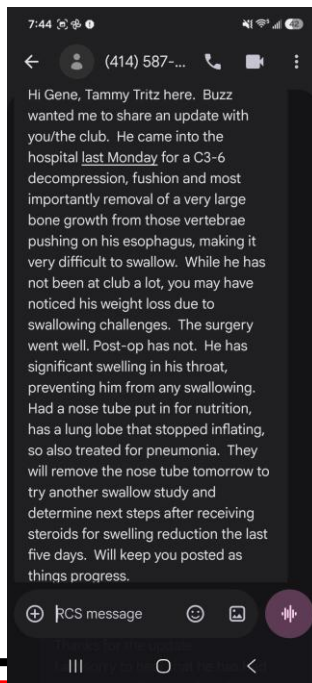
The deadline to convert silver certificate dollar bills into silver bullion. (1968)
